# **General** information

# Venue of the Conference

Conference will be held at the Field Scientific Station "Baltic Spit" of the Atlantic Branch of Shirshov's Institute of Oceanology of Russian Academy of Sciences, located in Kosa Village, City of Baltiysk, Kaliningrad Oblast (Province), Russian Federation.

# **Registration** fee

#### Accommodation

Conference fee will be reduced accordingly in this case.

#### **Publications**

Conference Proceedings with papers in English (accompanied by abstracts in Russian) will be published before the conference. Contributions should not exceed 6-10 pages for invited lecture and 3-5 pages for poster presentation (font Times New Roman, 12 pt, an interval 1.15) including full name of the author(-s), affiliation, and contact e-mail (phone/fax).

Figures and references should be included in a paper. Publishing costs will be covered by Russian Foundation for Basic Research, and therefore, abstracts in Russian for all published presentations are needed. Russian speaking participants are kindly requested to submit abstracts of their presentations not only in English, but also in Russian. Russian abstracts for non-Russian participants will be prepared by organizers.

#### Registration

Note that your passport should be valid for 6 months after the trip termination, i.e. until January, 2011.

Please note that the Visa must be issued by the Russian Consulate in your country. Official invitation which you will get from Organizing Committee is not a visa, and it has to be used as obligatory attachment to your personal visa application to the Russian Consulate in your country.
