<u>Key dates</u>

- deadline for application submission is extended up to March 1, 2011.

- deadline for the submission of the final version of the paper for publication – April 25, 2009.

Instructions for producing manuscript for the Proceedings

- the manuscript for plenary reports publication (following the recommendation of the Organizing Committee) should be in Word format, 10-page limit; for sectional reports – 5-page limit. The pages are not numbered.

the text should be set in Times New Roman, one-and-a half-spaced and indented on all sides by 2cm;
the text placement and type size: the 1st line – the title of the paper - centered, Times New Roman 14 pt boldface and in upper case; the 2nd line – the authors' names set in the center, Times New Roman 12 pt in lower case; the 3rd line – the name of organization and its e-mail(s) address set in the center,

Times New Roman 12 pt, lower case and sloping type; the abstract should be centered, Times New Roman 12 pt; the text should be set in Times New Roman 14 pt;

- the tables and the black and white figures are embedded in the text;

- references should be in square brackets and listed alphabetically at the end of the paper.

The paper (including the 10-line abstract in English) should be sent only by e-mail given in the "Contact information".
